2024 Regional Landscape Prize

Terms and Conditions

Applications Close August 4th at midnight 2024

Artists are invited to submit one landscape artwork of any medium (video excluded) to be judged by a panel of experts. This competition is open to emerging and established artists living in regional, rural and outback Australia. Artworks submitted may depict any type of landscape, eg. traditional, rural, abstract, suburban, imagined etc. There is a size limit of 80cm in any direction.

Our definition of "regional Australia" includes all areas OUTSIDE of capital cities in EVERY STATE and TERRITORY. If you live in Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Canberra, Adelaide, Perth, Darwin or Hobart you are NOT eligible.

If your artwork is chosen as a finalist, it will then be judged by our panel of experts and the winners will be announced on Opening Night.

Prizes

- **Major Prize:** \$5000 cash prize, courtesy of [Source Architects](#), awarded to the overall winner of the competition, and the opportunity to join our stable of artists.
- **Artists Residency:** A two-week residency, at [Quest Orange](#) in 2025, to complete a body of work inspired by the Orange landscape. The final body of work will be exhibited at The Corner Store Gallery once completed and they have the opportunity to join our stable of artists. This prize will be awarded to a finalist who demonstrates exceptional promise and who may best benefit from the opportunity. This finalist may or may not be the same artist as the Major Prize winner.

Exhibition Dates: September 11th to 22nd 2024

Successful entrants notified: August 11th 2024

Delivery of artworks in person: August 23rd between 10am and 4pm OR August 24th between 10am and 2pm.

Delivery of artwork by courier: by August 23rd

Opening Night and Winner Announcement: September 13th 6pm

Artworks will be selected on the following qualities:

Originality, creativity, concept, quality of work, skill shown, marketability, compatibility with our audience.

How to Enter

- Complete the application form online
- Pay the entry fee upon submission.
- Email at least two good quality photographs of the submitted work to cornerstoregallery@outlook.com

The Fine Print

- Entrants must submit only 1 artwork each - \$30 non-refundable entry fee applies to each submission
- Entry fees are not refundable under any circumstances
- The exhibition is open to all emerging and established artists residing in regional, rural and outback Australia. Please see our definition of "Regional Australia" above.
- Artworks submitted must have been completed in 2023 or 2024
- All mediums accepted, excluding digital or video artworks (our space does not allow for these mediums)
- Size limit of 80cm in any direction for each artwork (this includes frame)
- A gallery commission of 33% applies to all sales. This includes GST
- All work MUST be for sale
- We require artists, once their proposal has been accepted, to sign an artist agreement outlining artist and gallery's rights and responsibilities
- Artist payments are finalised up to 30 days after exhibition's end, lay-by will effect this timeframe.
- Finalists will be chosen by the Gallery Director - not all entries will be exhibited
- Entries from all levels of experience welcome
- It is the artists responsibility to ensure their artwork does not infringe on copyright
- All work will remain in the stockroom for three months following the close of the exhibition if not sold
- While all care is taken to ensure safety of artwork, the gallery takes no responsibility for damaged artwork. Artists are encouraged to insure their work if they are concerned
- The selection decision of the Gallery Director is final and no correspondence will be entered into
- The Corner Store Gallery reserves the right to make final curatorial decisions regarding the displayed works. The Exhibitor accepts that any work that exceeds the maximum size of 80cm in any direction will not be displayed and the Exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee.
- The artist's name AND title of the work MUST be written on the back of the work itself for clear identification. Unlabelled works may not be exhibited at discretion of gallery management, and in these cases the exhibition fee will not be refunded
- Works must be delivered on the set date ready for display. This includes all hanging attachments and appropriate framing detailed below. Arrangement and payment for special fixtures for hanging or display are the responsibility of the artist. All wall works MUST have d-rings attached as well as wires
- All freight charges of artworks to and from the gallery (excluding sold works) are the responsibility of the artist.

- All work on thin profile board or canvas (2cm or under) MUST be framed and ready to hang, thick profile is fine unframed. All work on paper MUST be framed and ready to hang. Please contact Madi on 0448 246 209 if you are unsure of framing requirements
- All photographs taken by Madeline Young are the property of The Corner Store Gallery and may not be used for commercial purposes. You may use them on your social media accounts to promote this exhibition only. They may not be used to promote any other exhibitions, opens studios etc. You MUST credit The Corner Store Gallery when sharing any images.

- Am I eligible if I live in metropolitan areas within Australia? NO (please check OUR definition of regional above)
- Am I eligible if I live outside of NSW? YES (if you live in a regional or rural area)
- Am I eligible if I've had work in a group exhibition at The Corner Store Gallery before? YES
- Am I eligible if I've had a solo exhibition at The Corner Store Gallery before? YES
- Am I eligible if I have never had work exhibited at The Corner Store Gallery before? YES
- Am I eligible if I have exhibited elsewhere before? YES
- Are all mediums accepted? NO we do not accept video works, all other mediums accepted.
- Can I submit more than 1 artwork? NO
- Is there a size limit? YES, artworks may not exceed 80cm in any direction.
- Do my wall works need to be framed? YES deep edge canvases and board are accepted unframed. If unsure please call Madi 0448 246 209.
- Are all entries accepted into the finalist exhibition? NO
- Is there an entry fee? YES. \$30 per artist (not refundable).
